



Go Help is a small UK charity that develops innovative fundraising events, specifically charity rallies to fund sustainable health and education projects across Central Asia.

Our two major fundraising events are the Mongolia Charity Rally, which has been operational since 2007 and the Roof of the World Rally to Tajikistan, which has been running since 2008. Go Help has worked extensively with a number of partner charities, in particular Save the Children and Sworde-Teppa as well as with government organisations in Mongolia and Tajikistan.

### Go Help's core objectives:

- To allow access to primary healthcare through the provision, distribution and maintenance of emergency vehicles.
- To foster local talent, through providing scholarships and employment opportunities.
- To support education projects which provide opportunities for literacy and self improvement.
- To facilitate the placement of skilled health & education volunteers with the aim of enhancing the capacity of local communities.

### Go Help in Tajikistan

To date, Go Help projects have been focussed on the Khatlon region of Tajikistan. This is a hot and dry region in the south west, adjoining the Afghanistan border.

### What do we do in Tajikistan?



#### *Sworde-Teppa*

Since 2008 the Go Help team has been supporting the small UK registered charity Sworde-Teppa. Sworde-Teppa is an English and Education Centre that offers a quality and free education to poorer Tajik children and also undertakes health outreach work. Go Help, via the Rally has been funding the running costs, and building improvements at Sworde-Teppa and a local Kindergarten in Qurghonteppe. We've provided a minibus to collect local children, and a 4x4 for rural health work. We work with the charity to facilitate gifts in kind and arrange volunteer teaching opportunities with teams.



#### *Ambulances*

In 2010 Go Help, proudly donated an excellent working ambulance to the maternity hospital in Qurghonteppe, with the aim of helping to lower maternal and infant death rates. This ambulance is monitored and well used and is the main ambulance serving approximately 90,000 people. Go Help has been asked for further ambulances.



#### *Save the Children*

In 2011 we have a new partnership with Save the Children. Go Help, via the Rally is supporting their 'Water and Sanitation in Schools' project aimed at sanitation improvements in 100 schools in Rasht and Qurghonteppe. Each community is donating labour and materials and Go Help is providing additional funds to augment the 100 school projects.
